

Applicants/current employees/volunteers and employees from other state agencies who work in California Department of Corrections (CDC) facilities or with CDC inmates are required to be evaluated for tuberculosis (TB) and certified to be free of TB in an infectious or contagious stage prior to assuming duties with the CDC and at least annually thereafter. The evaluation shall be done, by a physician and surgeon, in accordance with the most current recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. Certificates shall be submitted to and maintained by CDC.
