

STANDARDS OF CONDUCT FOR RELIGIOUS VOLUNTEERS

1. Giving or receiving anything from any inmate in the jurisdiction of the California Department of Corrections is prohibited.
2. Contact with family members of inmates through the mail, by telephone or personal contact is not allowed.
3. Do not give out personal telephone number or residence address to inmates.
4. Embracing, hugging or kissing inmates is not permitted.
5. Derogatory, discriminatory, or degrading remarks against any faith group is not acceptable at any time.
6. Coercion, intimidation, or embarrassment towards any inmate for the purpose of getting him to participate in the religious service being conducted is not acceptable at any time.
7. Inmate personal/family requests should be directed to the sponsor of your ministry.
8. Only give the ministry address to inmates who request specific needs or concerns.
9. Always be supportive of security and chaplains of the California Institution for Men.
10. All security violations should immediately be reported to security staff and ministry sponsor.

I understand the Standards of Conduct and agree to abide by them. I realize that violation of any of them may result in my dismissal from the religious volunteer program.
